

What changes would you like to see made to the Central City Curriculum? 24 responses None N/A Math review and focus on multiplying and dividing. The way math is taught is different to me with the "new" math. Makes no sense but I know its what is mandated to be taught. No. Notting I like that my children get the extra help they need they are doing so much better here then at other school Stop common core math. It makes it very difficult to help my children do things the same way they are taught in school as it was not something I myself learned. Better help from teachers during e-learning More time needs to be spent on math It seems like the school is trying to move too fast with the lessons and should spend more time focusing on the quality of lessons and not quantity of lessons. 7th Grade English has been very inconsistent this year. My husband and I both have a bachelors degree and we have had a terrible time navigating the home work and test preparations needed for this class. Our student takes notes during the class and studies the notes and often feels surprised at the material on the test. At times homework as well as the tests contradict what the teacher has taught in class. Books to go with computer so parents can see how to help and understand Several students who enter high school are behind in math and English. A majority of the CCS students are placed in math labs or lower math classes. The students can read and answer questions, but the writing and analyzing is often behind the other students. Not sure Health class for Junior high More parent teacher interaction We aren't big fans of the math series that is being used. The math for sixth grade is ridiculous with no help learning it for remote learners and they keep assigning it before they know what they are doing. Not very happy my son is failing with an F Nothing no no more common core math The teachers that are teaching the new math curriculum need more professional development on how to actually teach it in the classroom.

It's caused my child to have to do regular in person learning online.



At the beginni g of this school year, 2020-2021, my child tested in the yellow in RTI for reading. We read at home EVERY night. Well, I read her a book at bedtime. Being out for the end of 2020 hurt her scores. By the second RTI testing date, she was back up to green. War to go Central City staff!

CCS will be holding a summer school program for students who are at risk of failing a grade level or who have been indentified as needing additional help in order to recover many of their basic reading and math skills. 



I think Central City did an amazing job in spite of the circumstances of COVID-19. This has been such a difficult year for everyone and I think Central City excelled in how they handled things.




