My child loves to read. She has been reading lots of books.

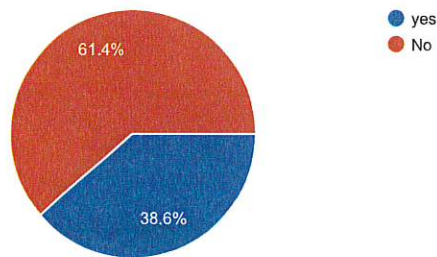

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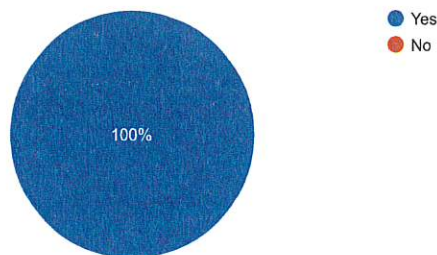

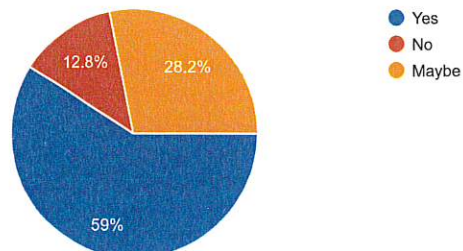

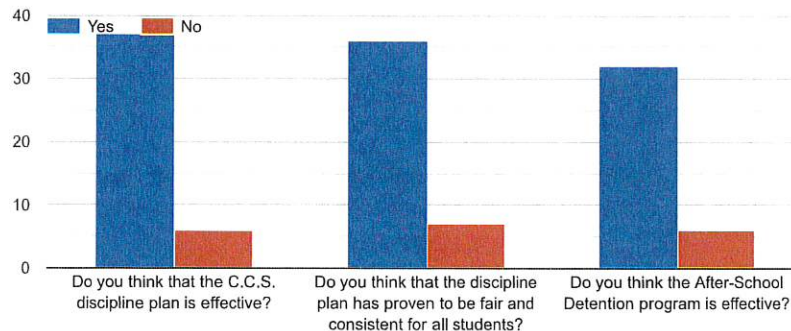
I would like to see the math and writing improve. It seems as if many students are behind in these two areas in high school and are placed in labs.

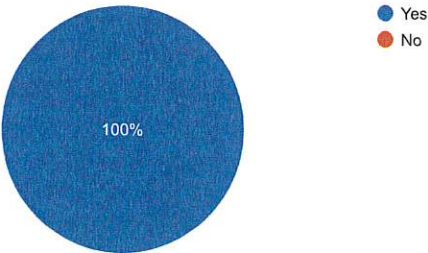

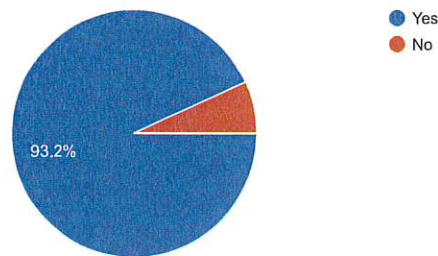

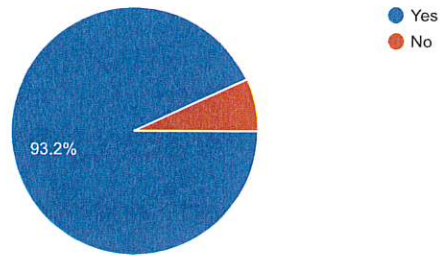

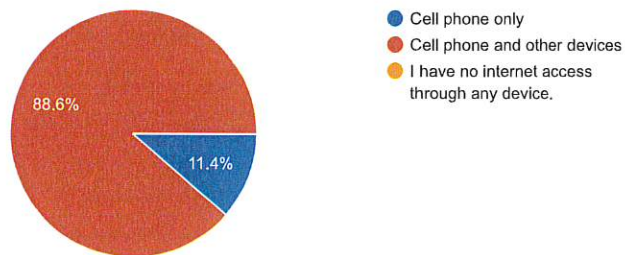

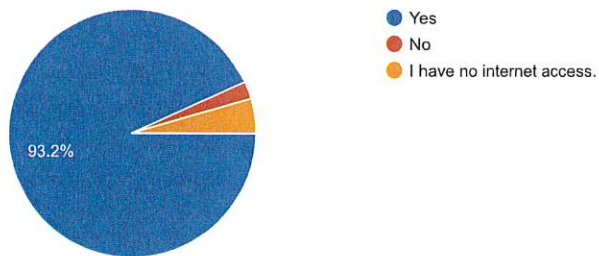

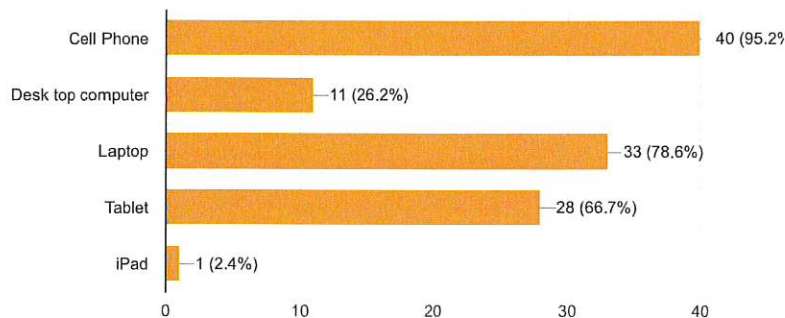

If you have internet what kinds of devices do you access the internet through at home?

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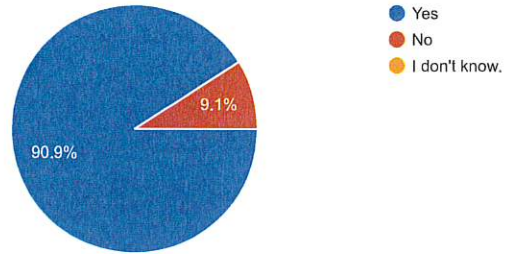

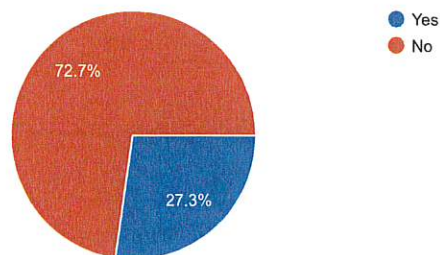

Not this year but infact last school year. Which has my children struggling this year.

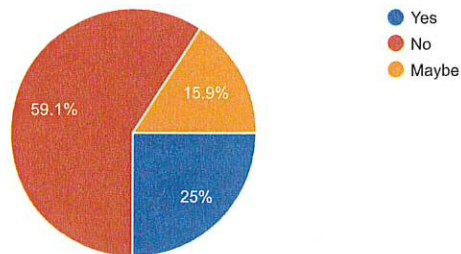

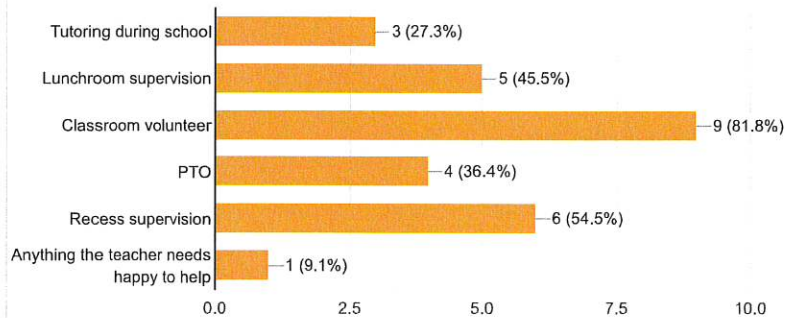

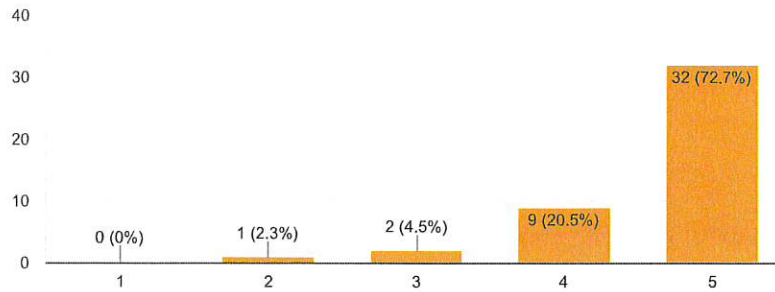

How safe from serious threats do you feel your child is when he/she is at school during regular school hours?



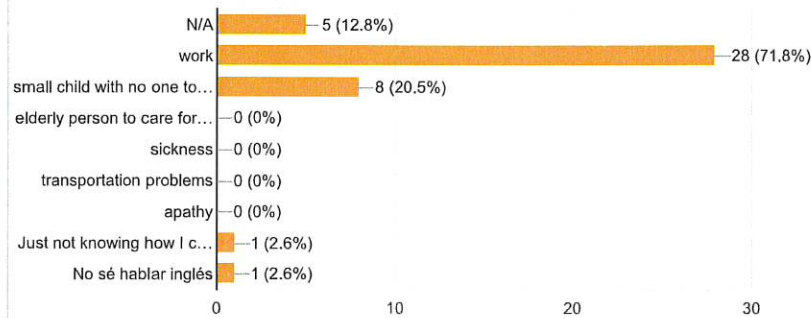

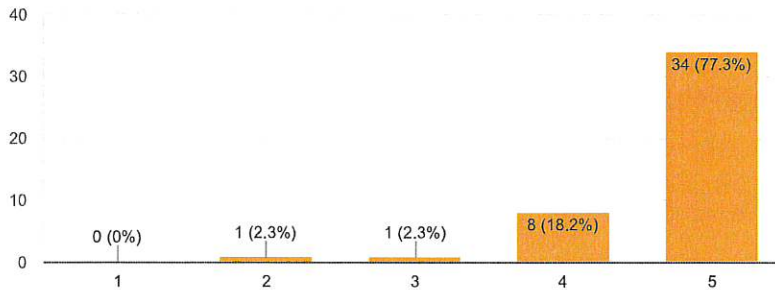
