## **Physical Education Grading Procedures**

Each student has the opportunity to earn 10 points per day in physical education. A student who achieves these points would exhibit the following criteria:

- Participates at his or her own superior level in the day's lesson
- Demonstrates positive behavior
- Cooperates with classmates, teammates, and the teacher
- Demonstrates respect for the teacher, classmates, and equipment

A student will lose points for demonstrating the following actions:

- Displaying poor sportsmanship
- Purposely not following rules/guidelines for the day's class
- Not supporting classmates
- Arguing with classmates or the teacher
- Participating at a minimal level
- Tardiness
- Horseplay/unsafe behavior
- Inappropriate language

A student will receive zero points for:

- Complete lack of participation in the activity
- An unexcused absence
- Non-compliance with P.E. Shoe policy
- Insubordination (refusal to comply with class instructions)
- Fighting/verbal harassment
- Destruction of school property/P.E. equipment
